UNIFORM DETAILS & REGULATIONS

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General

All students, Years 7-11 are expected to wear school uniform and sixth formers wear the sixth form uniform.

The Governors of All Saints expect parents to undertake to provide uniform for the student's entire school career.

The Governors, Headteacher and staff of All Saints expect parents to support the school in the reasonable enforcement of the uniform regulations.

Parents can purchase the All Saints school uniform including PE kit from our school supplier Khalsa Schoolwear (www.khalsaschoolwear.co.uk)

All items of school uniform, P.E. kit and bags must be clearly marked with the name of the student.

Red Items are the compulsory branded items (including tie)

PE kit**

The following PE kit is compulsory and can only be purchased at our school suppliers (www.khalsaschoolwear.co.uk).

1	Royal Blue Sports Top with School Badge
2	Royal Blue Shorts
3	Royal Blue PE Socks
4	Navy Blue Tracksuit with School Badge (optional)
	Gum Shields compulsory for Rugby lessons
	Shin Pads are compulsory for all Football lessons

The following regulations will apply:

1. House badges are part of the school uniform and must be worn on the left lapel on the student's blazer.
2. Hats/caps are not to be worn to school
3. All skirts must be box pleated and at least knee length. Side splits are not permitted.
4. Trousers must not be chino style or made from denim and must not be slim fit or legging style.
5. Ties must be a length that includes at least 5 fully visible blue stripes.
6. Trainers, trainer style shoes or boots are not acceptable as school shoes. Fashion shoes, including canvas shoes are also not permitted.
7. Overcoats and over jackets must be plain navy or black, must not contain logos or be of a denim or leather material.
8. Sweater tops and tracksuit tops are not permitted
9. Shirts must be tucked inside trousers and skirts.
10. Hijabs must be plain navy blue or black.
11. Scarves to be worn in the winter only. Navy blue or black colour only.
12. Hair must be neat and tidy and not dyed or coloured. Hair should be Grade 2 in length or above on all parts of the head and undercuts are not permitted. Lines must not be cut into hair or eyebrows and hair bands must be black and no wider than 2 inches.
13. Hair weaves must match the student's natural hair colour and must not create the appearance of a two-tone or contrasting colour variation. This includes styles that give the appearance of highlights, lowlights, or deliberately contrasting shades, even where natural variation in hair tone may occur.
14. Nail extensions are not permitted on Health and Safety grounds. Make up, nail varnish and eyelash extensions are not allowed.
15. Jewellery - Single watch, one pair of small ear studs (gold or silver) only, to be worn in the lobes. No chains, bracelets, rings or teeth jewellery. Nose studs or other facial piercings are not allowed.
16. Trousers must be worn on the hips and not sag below the hip line or at the crotch area. Students are not permitted to wear sports wear including PE kit under their trousers.

Any student who is not adhering to the uniform policy may receive one or more of the following sanctions until the uniform issues are corrected:

- **Parents will be requested to bring required items to school for their child.**
- **Removal from the general school population and supervised by their Year Leader for all lessons and including break time and lunch time to work with a pastoral leader or in the Damascus Suite.**
- **Confiscation and parent collection of items that are not school uniform.**
- **Detentions.**
- **Letter home to remain on pupil file.**

Sixth Form

Students in the sixth form must wear the correct clothing and attire as stipulated in the sixth form guidance. Uniforms should be purchased from (www.khalsaschoolwear.co.uk).

The following regulations will apply:

- All pupils should dress with modesty, dignity and in line with our school ethos.
- School blazers are a compulsory part of the uniform and must be worn correctly throughout the school day, including during lesson changeovers and around the school site.
- House badges are part of the school uniform and must be worn on the left lapel on the student's blazer.
- Skirts should be worn to the knee and should not be rolled up.
- Trousers must not be chino style or made from denim and must not be slim fit or legging style.
- Trainers, trainer style shoes or boots are not acceptable as school shoes. Fashion shoes, including canvas shoes are also not permitted.
- Overcoats and over jackets must be plain navy or black, must not contain logos or be of a denim or leather material.
- Sweater tops and tracksuit tops are not permitted.
- Shirts must be tucked inside trousers and skirts.
- Hijabs must be plain navy blue or black.
- Scarves to be worn in the winter only. Navy blue or black colour only.

- **Hair in 6th Form**

- Hair must be neat and tidy and not dyed or coloured. Hair should be Grade 2 in length or above on all parts of the head and undercuts are not permitted. Lines must not be cut into hair or eyebrows and hair bands must be black and no wider than 2 inches.
- Hair weaves must match the student's natural hair colour and must not create the appearance of a two-tone or contrasting colour variation. This includes styles that give the appearance of highlights, lowlights, or deliberately contrasting shades, even where natural variation in hair tone may occur.
- For health and safety reasons, hair worn loose should not extend below the waist. Students with hair longer than waist length must ensure it is securely tied back while in school.

- **Makeup/Nails/Earrings/Jewellery**

- No artificial nails permitted. Nail extensions are not permitted on Health and Safety grounds.
- Make up, nail varnish and eyelash extensions are not allowed.
- Jewellery - Single watch, one pair of small ear studs (gold or silver) only.
- No chains, bracelets, rings or teeth jewellery. Nose studs or other facial piercings are not allowed.

- **PE**

- Students may wear their own sportswear for PE lessons where permitted by the department.
- All clothing must be suitable for physical activity and appropriate for a school environment.
- Sportswear should be modest, preserve dignity, and reflect the values and ethos of the school.
- Items deemed excessively revealing, inappropriate, or unsafe for PE activities may not be worn.

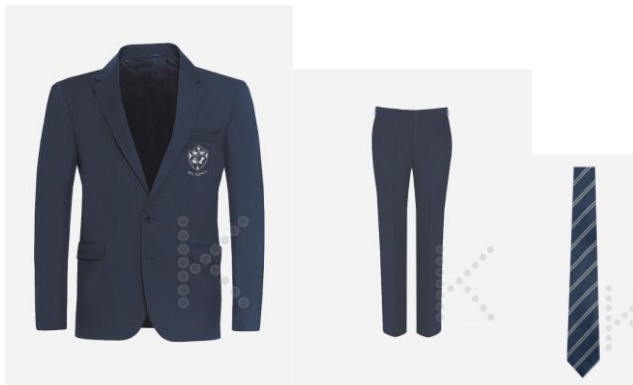
